Barracks riding	Every Tuesday	Dressage lessons for intermediate and advanced riders. Times 18:30 & 19:30. Cost £27.50. If you are interested you need to be assessed before your first ride as the horses can occasionally be lively!	
Vauxhall riding	Every Wednesday	Lessons for beginner, novice and intermediate riders. Times 18:00 to 20:00. Cost £25. Private or small group lesson are available. Vauxhall only have ponies and one horse so weight limits can apply.	
Trent Park riding	Every Thursday	Lessons for all abilities. Dressage or jumping. Some hacking is also available. Times 19:30 or 20:30. Cost around £25 but varies	
Polo at Apsley End Polo Club, Herts	Monthly	Monthly lessons for beginners and the more advanced, both at £50. Courses also available and can be tailored to individual or group requirements. All facilities including floodlit arena, full outside grass pitch and wooden horse.	
Hacking at Flemish Farm	Some club dates may be arranged across the year, or you can book direct	The club has affiliated to the HACLC which gives us use of the horses at Flemish Farm. Horses can be hacked around Great Windsor Park. Cost circa £38 per 2 hours. Flat/jumping lessons also available	
Lessons at Flemish Farm	As above	Dressage or jumping available for all abilities. Cost £28 for a 1hr group lesson, £34 for semi-private and £40 for private.	
Stable management lessons at Vauxhall	Currently Wednesdays 18:00 to 20:00	Will primarily be aimed at those with only basic horsey knowledge, but more advanced e.g. for BHS stage exams could be arranged if there is interest. <i>(please specify level)</i>	
Day courses at Contessa Riding Centre, Herts.	No set dates yet	Day courses involve two ridden lessons, two lectures and a demonstration. Costs around £60. Contessa have experienced dressage horses. Jumping and novice lessons are also available. Great value!	
Trekking at White Horses Trekking Centre, Wiltshire	No set date	Weekday or weekend trekking can be arranged if there is sufficient interest	
Pub nights	1st Tuesday of every month	At the Tattersall Tavern, Knightsbridge. Takes place from around 19:30 onwards after the Tuesday Barracks rides. It's best to contact Nancy (07980 223452) first to confirm it will be going ahead.
